 <p>Excavator Excavators are heavy construction equipment consisting of a boom, dipper (or stick), bucket and cab on a rotating platform known as the "house". The house sits atop an undercarriage with tracks or wheels.</p>	 <p>Level II First Aid This course describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to a casualty. The unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.</p>
 <p>Skidsteer A skidsteer is a small, rigid-frame, engine-powered machine with lift arms used to attach a wide variety of labour-saving tools or attachments.</p>	 <p>Traffic Control Control Traffic with a Stop Slow Bat covers controlling of traffic with a stop slow bat in resources and infrastructure industries. It includes planning and preparing, coordinating traffic, operating radios and cleaning</p>
 <p>Roller A roller is a compactor type engineering vehicle used to compact soil, gravel, concrete, or asphalt in the construction of roads and foundations</p>	 <p>Traffic Management This unit develops a participant's skills and knowledge required to implement a traffic management plan in civil construction. This unit is appropriate for those working in supervisory roles.</p>
 <p>Tip Truck A tip truck is used for transporting loose material (such as dirt). It has an open-box bed, which is hinged at the rear and equipped with hydraulic pistons to lift the front, allowing the material in the bed to be deposited ("dumped") on the ground</p>	 <p>Operate Skid steer with attachments This unit describes a participant's skills and knowledge required to conduct operations with skid steer loaders using attachments</p>
 <p>Tractor A tractor is an engineering vehicle designed to deliver a high tractive effort (or torque) at slow speeds, for the purposes of hauling a trailer or machinery used in agriculture or construction.</p>	 <p>Working At Heights This unit specifies the competency required to undertake safe working practices when working at heights or depths.</p>
 <p>Elevating Work Platform An elevating work platform (EWP) is a mechanical device used to provide temporary access to inaccessible areas, usually at height. May also be known as a "cherry picker" or a "scissor lift".</p>	 <p>Load and Unload Plant This unit covers loading and unloading plant and equipment for transportation in the resources and infrastructure industries. It will equip you with the skills to do the job safely in line with the national standard.</p>
 <p>Forklift A forklift (also called a lift truck, a fork truck, or a forklift truck) is a powered industrial truck used to lift and move materials short</p>	 <p>Specialised Forklift Operations This unit involves operating a forklift with specialised attachments or all-terrain equipment including checking attachments and worksite for suitability and by selecting forklift and accessories for load shifting tasks</p>
